Lindblad-National Geographic Expeditions' New Baja Voyage Offers \$550 Air Credit


Expedition Highlights include:

- Hike a desert arroyo to see ancient art, handprints hidden in a cave for millennia, and feel a connection to the ancients in this high, remote desert.
- Snorkel at Cabo Pulmo, a vibrant reef and model for ocean conservation; and with the sea lions at Los Islotes.
- Kayak, swim, and hike the pristine desert islands of the Sea of Cortez, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

This is the ideal voyage for a shared holiday experience for families to enjoy together and apart. Organized activities inspire curiosity in kids of all ages and may include hands-on science with a video microscope to view and identify undersea specimens; journal making; scavenger hunts onboard and on excursions; expedition landing craft-driving lessons; photo sessions with the photo instructor; lessons in star gazing; bridge time with the Captain and his crew learning navigation and mapping; kid-friendly menu options, and impromptu pizza movie nights.

Rates begin at \$5,690 per person based on double occupancy in a category 1 cabin. To receive the special \$550 airfare credit, guests must book their voyage by July 31, 2014. The air credit is valid on new bookings only and not combinable with other offers.
