Steam from Ushuaia, Argentina, across the Drake Passage to the Antarctic Peninsula on the 14-day Journey to Antarctica: The White Continent from **Lindblad Expeditions-National Geographic** (*expeditions.com*; from \$11,990 per person). Veteran naturalists such as author Stefan Lundgren lead hikes past penguin colonies, Zodiac land excursions, and kayak tours through ice floes, where you'll spot leopard seals and the occasional orca. Wildlife photographers are also on hand to give photo lessons.
