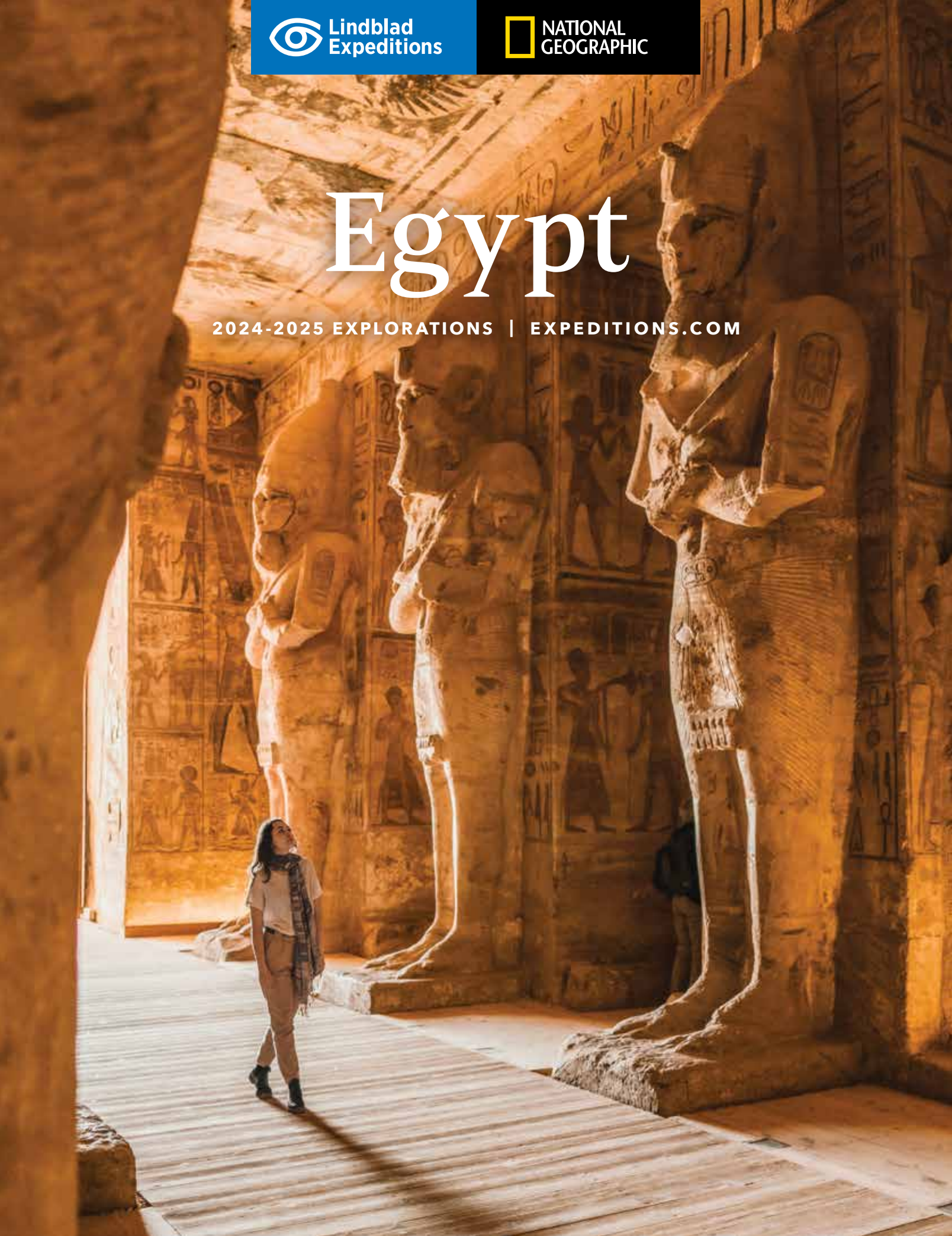

Descend into the royal tomb of Seti I—widely regarded as the most stunning chamber in the Valley of the Kings—and marvel at its vaulted ceilings, painted in brilliant blue astronomical scenes. Enjoy the rare opportunity to discover the lesser-visited Valley of the Queens, which shelters Nefertari's exquisite tomb, painted in vibrant images of her lovely likeness. And venture far beyond the banks of the Nile to Egypt's best-preserved temple at Dendera, adorned with unusual paintings of Roman emperors alongside the typical Egyptian deities.

Our expeditions in Egypt never exceed 60 travelers, which guarantees you a richer and more personal experience amid the temples and tombs of this ancient realm. With a ratio of one Egyptologist guide for every 20-25 guests, you can satisfy your curiosity about the many mysteries and accomplishments of this great civilization. Our small group size also allows us access to popular sights at off-peak hours, so we can linger long after the crowds are gone.

OPENING IN 2024:

The Grand Egyptian Museum

Be among the first to discover the treasures on display at the Grand Egyptian Museum, opening to the public in 2024. This highly anticipated institution holds the world's largest collection of ancient artifacts—more than 100,000 antiquities—including the entire assortment of jewelry, weaponry, clothing, and other treasures recovered from King Tut's tomb, all on display in one location for the first time since archaeologist Howard Carter unearthed them in 1922.

One of the seven wonders of the ancient world, the Pyramids of Giza have stood atop Saharan sands for some 4,500 years.

Premier Accommodations On Land & On the Water

Experience Egypt's storied history and legendary beauty from a luxurious Nile ship and Cairo's finest hotel accommodations.

Oberoi Philae

A six-night Nile exploration is the centerpiece of our **Passage Through Egypt** expedition, and you will sail aboard one of the most elegant ships on the river today: *Oberoi Philae*. The recently remodeled vessel accommodates just 22 spacious cabins, each with French balconies that reveal scenes of the Nile's swaying date palms and bobbing feluccas. *Oberoi Philae* also has private docking privileges in busy ports like Luxor and Aswan, allowing us to bypass places where tourists congregate and avoid delays from boat traffic.



After unhurried days spent discovering ancient temples and monuments, head to the top deck for a refreshing dip in the sizable pool or a cold beverage at the al fresco cocktail bar. An enclosed restaurant on the lower deck is lined with panoramic windows and serves up a mix of Middle Eastern dishes and continental favorites. The spa area offers a range of massages and other treatments, along with a fitness center to accommodate wellness needs.





Sun Goddess

Enjoy a four-night journey along the Nile aboard *Sun Goddess* during the **Exploring Egypt expedition**. This elegant vessel is outfitted with 30 beautifully appointed suites, each with a separate sitting area and balcony where you can watch daily life unfurl along the riverbanks. Inviting shared spaces, including a sleek bar and dining room, blend plush furnishings with Egyptian décor and artwork to evoke the ambiance of a chic boutique hotel.



As *Sun Goddess* sails between the Nile's vibrant ports of call, settle into a lounge on the sun deck and soak in scenes of verdant palms backed by sweeping Saharan sands. The refreshing pool and spa treatment rooms invite further relaxation, while an on-board 'bazaar' offers the chance to browse fine Egyptian goods from the comfort of the ship.



Private Aircraft

For flights within Egypt, you will travel aboard charter aircraft reserved just for our group, which allows us to fly at ideal times and avoid commercial air disruptions. Enjoy the luxury of exploring at your own pace in places like Abu Simbel, where other tours are typically rushed to adhere to commercial flight schedules.

The St. Regis Cairo

Situated in the heart of the city, this five-star hotel features sweeping views over the Nile River and Old Cairo. Guests enjoy lavishly appointed accommodations and the hotel's signature butler service, as well as their choice of seven on-site restaurants, all overlooking the water. The property also features indoor and outdoor pools, a fitness center, and a spa.

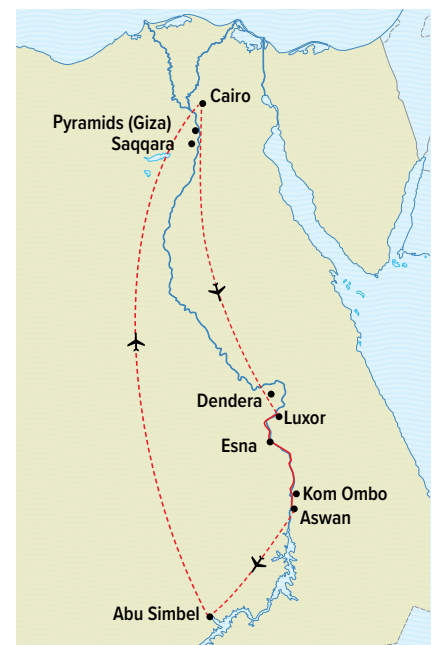

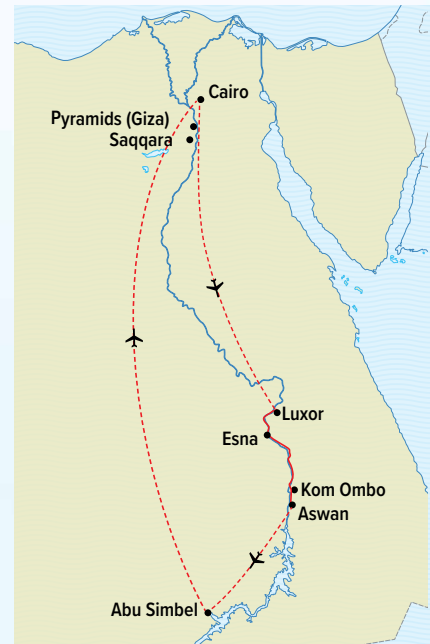

Jordan

POST-VOYAGE | 6 DAYS | FROM \$4,370

Sitting at the crossroads of ancient civilizations, the desert sands and fertile valleys of Jordan lend a dramatic backdrop to ancient Nabatean monuments, Roman ruins, and vibrant Islamic cities. Beginning in capital city Amman, we'll visit Jerash, where one hundred years of excavation have unearthed just one percent of this former Roman metropolis. Continue to Petra, the Nabatean city whose iconic rose-hued facades are carved directly into sandstone cliffs. In Madaba, see the remarkable 6th-century mosaic map, then venture to the Dead Sea for a relaxing float. Throughout your journey, you'll be accompanied by a top guide and stay in superb accommodations.

Cairo

Delve deeper into Cairo's illustrious past with two additional nights at the St. Regis or Conrad Cairo. Explore Old Cairo, the city's earliest original settlement, home to an ancient Coptic Christian community. Visit the Ibn Tulun Mosque and the Gayer Andersen Museum, which exhibits a trove of Arab antiquities. You will also have the opportunity to tour the newly restored Baron Empain Palace—also known as "Le Palais Hindou," or the Hindu palace—built by Belgian millionaire Baron Edward Empain in 1911.

Oberoi Philae

Her scale, décor, and renowned service defines *Oberoi Philae* as the finest ship on the Nile. She has the intimate size and appointments of a luxury yacht, with the spaciousness and gracious hospitality of a luxury hotel. Savor her private and public spaces—with complimentary wireless internet access throughout the ship.

Capacity: 44 guests in 22 cabins including 4 suites (2 with private terrace and jacuzzi tub).

Registry: Egypt. **Overall Length:** 235 feet.

The *Oberoi Philae* originally began service in 1996, configured at the time with 50 cabins and with a maximum capacity of 100 guests. A multiyear renovation completed in 2015 converted her into an extraordinarily beautiful, private ship, with just 22 cabins, modern amenities, and a relaxed, elegant ambiance.

Public Areas: There is a great deal of attractive and comfortable public space. Deck E is a perfect place to relax and watch life along the Nile. The 36-foot-long swimming pool, surrounded by lounge chairs, is among the largest of any Nile ship. Some meals are served al fresco in the covered sitting area. Deck D has a fully equipped spa with treatment rooms, and

there is a selection of spa treatments and massages available with a professional masseuse as well as a fitness room with cardio and weight machines. Deck C has a lounge and library, ideal for reading about Egyptian history. On Deck B you'll find the main lounge, which is the venue for talks and presentations. And Deck A has the elegant restaurant. There are three water coolers available on board for your convenience to refill personal water bottles.

Meals: Served in single seatings, meals focus on fine Egyptian, Middle Eastern, and Continental cuisine. Refreshments are always available. Lunch is occasionally served on Deck E, weather permitting.

Cabins: All cabins and suites are elegant and very spacious. All face outside, with French balconies which open to offer great views of the Nile. There is ample storage space for luggage and personal items. Each cabin has a 40-inch flat panel TV, DVD player, mini-fridge, safe, hair dryer, individual climate controls, and remote control-operated blackout blinds. Laundry service is included. There is a mix of queen-bedded and twin-bedded cabins.

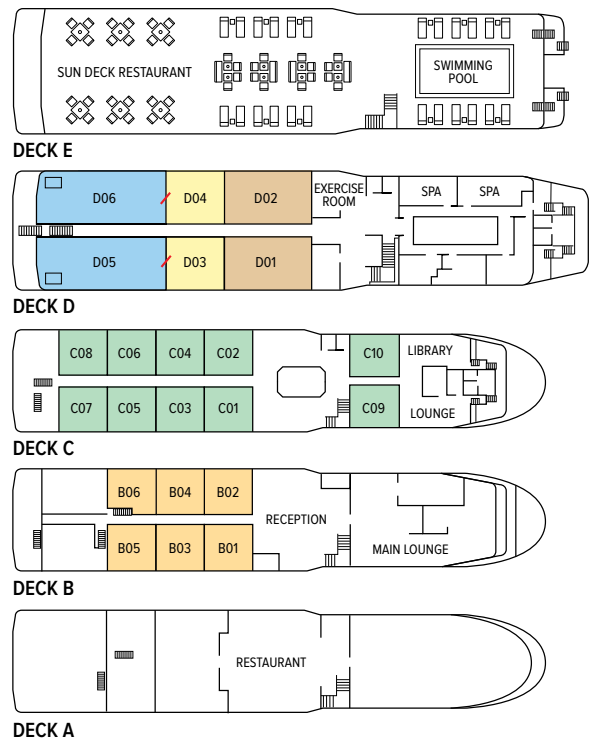
CATEGORY 1: #B01-B06: These cabins are 388 square feet, located on Deck B and have single beds that can be pushed together to make a queen, sitting area, sliding glass windows with French balcony, and a shower.

CATEGORY 2: #C01-C10: These cabins are 388 square feet, located on Deck C and have single beds that can be pushed together to make a queen, sliding glass windows with French balcony, and a shower.

CATEGORY 3: #D03-D04: These cabins are 388 square feet, located on Deck D and have two single beds that can be pushed together to make a queen, sitting area, sliding glass windows with a French balcony, and a shower.

CATEGORY 4: #D01-D02: These luxury suites are 580 square feet, located on Deck D and have a queen bed, sliding glass windows with French balcony, separate living area, shower, and a stand-alone tub.

CATEGORY 5: #D05-D06: These luxury suites are 580 square feet with a 323 square feet balcony with heated outdoor whirlpool and sun lounger located on Deck D and have a queen bed, sliding glass windows with French balcony, separate living area, shower, and a stand-alone tub.





Sun Goddess

A new addition to our Egypt offerings, the elegant *Sun Goddess* carries a maximum of only 60 guests in 30 spacious suites, providing an intimate and exceptionally comfortable experience on the world's longest river. Featuring a separate sitting area and balconies, each suite is a relaxing and sophisticated environment to observe 5,000 years of history unfolding along the Nile's banks.

Capacity: 60 guests in 30 suites.

Registry: Egypt **Overall Length:** 245 feet.

Recently renovated in 2019, *Sun Goddess* is awash in soothing natural wood tones and an inviting ambiance that imbues all five decks. Of the ship's many common spaces, the highlight is her expansive Sun Deck whose open-air amenities offer panoramic views of the Nile. With lounge chairs shaded by umbrellas, alfresco dining, and a refreshing swimming pool and Jacuzzi, it's an enticing place to rest and recharge between visits to the region's extraordinary temples and tombs.

Public Areas: Natural wood tones with pops of vibrant color, gold-toned décor accents, Egyptian-themed artwork, and potted palms set the stage for the graceful public spaces. Sip on a cocktail during the evening Recap in the lounge. Relax on the Sun Deck, enjoying

alfresco dining and a dip in the swimming pool or Jacuzzi. Take a break from exploring to enjoy a massage treatment or a sauna in the Spa or get in a workout in the Fitness Room, which includes a treadmill and exercise bike. Or recline in a lounge chair and simply observe life on the Nile as boats float by and oxen drink along the banks as they have for millennia.

Dining: The ship's airy and elegant dining room accommodates the entire expedition community in one seating. Enjoy high-quality cuisine that's focused on both local and Continental dishes, with options for vegetarians as well as other dietary needs. An expansive breakfast buffet is included daily while lunches and dinners are a mix of plated, family-style, or buffet depending on the day's schedule. Meals are occasionally served on Deck 5.

Cabins: Experience the casual pace of life on the river from your balcony. All of the ship's 30 spacious suites have a separate sitting area and a balcony. Bathrooms are all fitted with a full-sized bathtub and shower. All cabins also feature a mini-bar, safe, music system, TV, individual climate control, and hairdryer. Laundry service is included, and there's ample storage. There is a mix of queen-bedded and king-bedded suites.

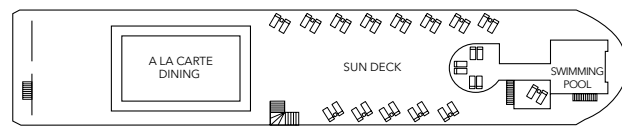


Left to right: The Sun Goddess sails the Nile; the lounge; Executive suite interior; Presidential suite interior

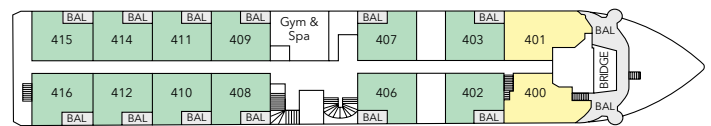

CATEGORY 2: Presidential Suites: #402-416: 430 square feet. These spacious suites feature queen beds, separate seating area, sliding glass door opening to a private balcony with seating, and private bathroom with full-sized bathtub.

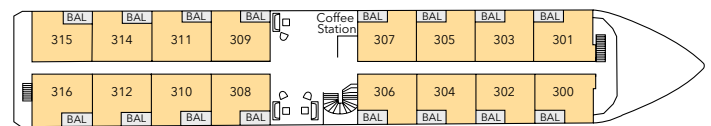
