

# Dive Into the Galápagos Marine Reserve

## Take the opportunity to scuba dive with incredible sea life

The Galápagos Islands sit at the heart of converging ocean currents that give rise to an abundance of sea life, making the archipelago one of the world's great diving destinations.

Certified and experienced divers on select departures aboard *National Geographic Endeavour II* can take advantage of the option to scuba dive in this spectacular marine world.



Experience close encounters with iconic Galápagos creatures like sea lions and sea turtles, and go beyond the surface to witness denizens of the deep—from garden eels to eagle rays and hammerhead sharks—and fascinating volcanic features along the seafloor. Divers will have the chance to meet a local dive boat at two of the destinations on our itinerary, with opportunities for two dives in each destination.

## PREPARATION & PACKING

For our Galápagos scuba diving excursions, we partner with Scuba Iguana, an experienced operator with permission from the Galápagos National Park Service to operate in this protected marine reserve. All divers must be certified by an internationally recognized dive association (e.g., PADI, NAUI) and bring proof of certification and dive insurance, as well as logs detailing their latest dives, to the Galápagos. Divers must be pre-qualified and reserve their space in advance. Limited availability. Galápagos is for experienced divers only.

## PRICING

Equipment, dive guide, and lunch are included on this optional excursion. Diving is available on two days (Floreana and Santa Cruz islands) on the San Cristobal to Baltra (eastern) itinerary.
