

## Packing List – Sailing the Greek Isles

First of all, the atmosphere aboard is casual; after all, it is an expedition. However, more formal attire is recommended for welcome and farewell evenings. Additionally, many guests prefer to dress up for dinner – *Sea Cloud* is so elegant that many people simply feel more comfortable in something a bit “spiffier” at dinner. Women may want to bring blouses and skirts or simple dresses and men may like sports jackets, although this is entirely optional.

Note: You may have opportunities to visit Greek Orthodox churches along the way. To enter, you need to be dressed modestly. Women need to wear skirts (we carry wraps for women to use if needed), and men need to wear long trousers. Your expedition staff will advise you on days when this may apply.

Please remember that the sun is strong in Greece, and you can sunburn easily. We recommend that you be prepared with sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat, and limit your exposure to direct sunlight.

Your Packing List

<input type="checkbox"/> A lightweight raincoat, rain poncho, or collapsible umbrella.
<input type="checkbox"/> Comfortable walking shoes with rubber soles and good support (for aboard ship and shore excursions). Most people find tennis shoes or sneakers suitable. You may want to bring two pairs so that you will have a dry pair if one should get wet or muddy.
<input type="checkbox"/> “Teva” or similar sandals. These are lightweight, rubber sandals with adjustable ankle straps, available at sporting goods stores.
<input type="checkbox"/> A sweater, sweatshirt, and/or jacket. Some people find the air-conditioning aboard to be cool, so a light sweater that can be worn in the evenings is advisable.
<input type="checkbox"/> One or two bathing suits.
<input type="checkbox"/> Usual assortment of short and long-sleeved pants and shirts and other layered clothing.
<input type="checkbox"/> Sport jacket and slacks for men, dress or skirt and blouse for women, for dinners aboard ship.
<input type="checkbox"/> Sunscreen, sunglasses, and a wide-brimmed hat for sun protection.
<input type="checkbox"/> Waterproof insect repellent.
<input type="checkbox"/> A small backpack or rucksack; a waterproof bag to hold your camera and/or binoculars.
<input type="checkbox"/> A collapsible walking stick, if you prefer walking with one.
<input type="checkbox"/> Binoculars, if you would like to utilize them on this expedition.
<input type="checkbox"/> Camera, lenses, and plenty of film and/or memory cards, and extra batteries.
<input type="checkbox"/> Travel alarm clock.
<input type="checkbox"/> An adaptor or adaptors to the two-prong round European plug for any appliances you plan to use, and a voltage converter if you should need it.

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
