

Packing List – Scotland

However, for the farewell dinner, you may want to have something slightly dressier, a blouse and skirt or a simple dress for women and a sports jacket for men, although this is entirely optional.

Voyage Packing List
<input type="checkbox"/> Lightweight rain gear, such as waterproof pants and jacket, or a poncho under which you can wear warm pants and a sweater.
<input type="checkbox"/> Waterproof , well-fitting hiking boots with strong, non-skid soles.
<input type="checkbox"/> Comfortable walking shoes with rubber soles and good support. Most people find tennis shoes or sneakers suitable. You may want to bring two pairs in case one gets wet.
<input type="checkbox"/> Cotton slacks (khakis, jeans, corduroy).
<input type="checkbox"/> Short and long-sleeved shirts and blouses.
<input type="checkbox"/> Two or three different weight sweaters (one of each).
<input type="checkbox"/> Sweatshirts or a fleece outfit and a warm jacket.
<input type="checkbox"/> Collapsible umbrella.
<input type="checkbox"/> Waterproof insect repellent.
<input type="checkbox"/> Lotions/creams for sun and wind protection.
<input type="checkbox"/> Camera, lenses, instruction manual, plenty of memory cards/film, battery charger and extra batteries.

<input type="checkbox"/> A small backpack or rucksack; a waterproof bag to hold your camera and/or binoculars.
